As part of the Music Education major, students in this program must:

- ◁ demonstrate piano proficiency. Students complete four semesters of class piano or take a proficiency exam within the first year of course work. Piano proficiency must be completed by their junior year in order to proceed to upper-level applied lessons.
- ◁ earn a “C” or better in each major course (MUS, MUEN, MUAP)
- ◁ a grade of C or better is required in CMST 101, ENGL 101, SGR #5 Mathematics, and in all education coursework

As part of the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, students in this program must complete/earn:

- ◁ a minimum of 33 upper division credits (300-400 level courses)
- ◁ a capstone course in the major (student teaching)
- ◁ a designated diversity, equity, and inclusion course - AIS 211 for teaching students
